#### 4. GENERAL INFORMATION

Length of the Rally is approx. 398km including 10 special stages, which cover approx. over 121km.  
For the classes 14-23 total is approx. 231km including 5 special stages (SS 4-8), which cover approx. 66km.

If the competitor or any representative of him or her is seen on route of the Rally before start or in the communities of Kangasala, Hattula, Lempäälä, Pälkäne, Sastamala, Valkeakoski, Vesilahti and Akaa, on the roads marked by yellow, green, grey or black in the Finnish GT Map or on unmarked roads in the same area, the competitor will be excluded from this rally.

Alternative turning marks will be used in this event. (Turning arrows by national Finnish Rally Regulations nr 1A and 2A)

### 5.1 COMPETITORS

Event is a NEAFP- event and thereby open to license holders of other countries ASN's.

### 6. ENTRIES

Anyone wishing to take part of the Lake City Rally must submit the entry through KIT1 – system (License holder of Finnish ASN [AKK-Motorsport ry]). Other countries ASN license holders will fill the entry form from official website of the Rally <http://www.lakecityrally.fi>. The maximum number of entries is fixed for 180 crews. Should the number of entries exceed this number, crews who have entered to the classes 1-7 will be given the priority.

When entering the rally, competitors must inform the organizer the type of fuel they wish to use and the method of refueling. If use E85 fuel there isn't capacity for use only pump refuels during the route.

### 8. SERVICE

During the rally, there is one service park which is located at the Rally HQ. Service is allowed only in this area.

The organizer reserves each crew a service area of 6m x 8m. Teams who have entered to Team's Championship are being arranged service space according Finnish Rally Championship regulations. For any special requirements, a specific application with measurements of needed area must be made until 25<sup>th</sup> of September 2017 at 18:00 (6pm UTC +2) by email: [servicepark@lakecityrally.fi](mailto:servicepark@lakecityrally.fi). After this time period organizer will charge 150 euros per competitor for any changes. The organizer reserves the right not to accept the requests of any competitors.

Service vehicles must be equipped per extinguisher and an absorption mat ready for use and rally car throughout at least the bottom area of the size liquid-impermeable protective mask during maintenance operations. The absence of any one of these will result in immediate competition leader decision to exclusion.

Penalties in the service area:	1. infringement	300 €
	2. infringement	600 €

## 9. REFUELING

Refueling is only allowed on the gas stations or refuel zone's which are marked in the Road Book of the Lake City Rally 2017. Details will be published in the Rally Guide.

## 10. RECONNAISSANCE (not for the classes 14 - 23)

28<sup>th</sup> of September at 17.00 (5pm UTC+2) – 21.00 (9pm) and 29<sup>th</sup> of Sep. from 6.00 (6am) crews can pick up reconnaissance material from the Rally Office in Rally HQ RealPark Lempäälä. At registration, each competitor must give for organizer details of the car used for reconnaissance and contact details of his/her mobile phone.

At the administrative checks/registration for reconnaissance I-driver must present driving license and co-driver must present ID. Both drivers must present drivers' competition licenses, competitor/entrant license (if other than drivers), and authorization for the drivers by their ASN to take part in the rally. Both drivers have to present their licenses and other documents personally.

Recce car identification stickers (2 pcs) given by the organizer must be attached in the recce vehicle in the middle of windscreen and to right rear side glass. These identification stickers must be visible during the whole duration of the reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance starts 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2017 at 06.00 (6 am) and ends 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2017 at 16.30 (4.30 pm).

During the recce speed limit is 80km/h at all special stages, unless a lower speed limit is set by traffic signs or with limit signs set up by organizer. Driving conduct may not endanger or disturb other traffic or the local residents. Organizer prohibits any other traffic against the direction of the rally at the special stages, expect one SS regarding reconnaissance guide what is distributed with other reconnaissance material. Organizer will also control speed and driving conduct during recce. Local police will also control speed and driving conduct during the recce. Local Police may punish competitors of any violations of local traffic rules. All competitors must obey all road and stop signs, also they must obey rally officials if they use hand held signs for STOP or others. If not, penalty will be exclusion from the Rally.

GPS – tracking system device will be given to crews from organizer at the registration for reconnaissance and it's mandatory to use and keep power on. **The competitors must be reserved USB power supply for the GPS tracking system device and keep the device connected (charging) during the reconnaissance time.**

Reconnaissance is allowed with the following restrictions: All special stages may only be driven twice during reconnaissance, including even those special stages which are used twice during the Rally.

Organizer will monitor amount of the reconnaissance and speed by GPS – tracking system which generated report 's automatically and leaves no room for any interpretation.

**The competitor is obliged to transfer GPS tracking device after the recce to their rally car.**

From speeding during the recce measured by the police or the Rally organizer will Clerk of the Course impose following penalties:

1. infringement: notice
2. infringement: fine 90 €
3. infringement: fine 200 €
4. infringement: refusal to start

Fines must be paid to Rally Office 30 minutes before competitors starting time, or refusal to start will be imposed.

## 11. ADVERTISING

In competitor's number stickers advertisements will be published in the Rally Guide.

Windscreen sticker: In competitor's own use, as it is in the regulations of Finnish Rally Championship.

## 12. RUNNING OF THE RALLY

### 12.1 Start of the Rally

Starting times of the crews will be given at the official notice board in the Rally Office. Timecards are given to competitors at Start TC 0 which is situated in the Rally HQ, in Areenakatu, Lempäälä.

Start of the Rally takes place at 29<sup>th</sup> of September from 18.01 and start signal is given at one minute intervals to each crew.

Transponder of timekeeping must collect from Rally Office at least one hour before crews starting time.

Transponder and GPS-tracking device will be returned at finish TC 10C or in case of retire they must be given to the sweeper car or nearest TC point.

### 12.2 Leg 1.

If competitor retires from rally during Leg 1 or his/her start is refused by scrutineering, the competitor may repair the car and participate to Leg 2. Competitor must announce his/her will to start for Leg 2 in writing latest 29.09.2017 until 23.00 o'clock to the Rally Office. His/her time for the undriven Special Stages will be the fastest time in his/her class + 5 minutes. If crew will retire after the Leg 1 last special stage, sentenced to a competitor within five +5-minute time penalty.

The rally car of any retired competitor, who wishes to continue the rally for Leg 2. Must present rally car for scrutineering in area of Rally HQ Parc Fermé, RealPark Lempäälä, one hour before starting time of 1st competitor for Leg 2. Cars which pass this unique scrutineering are allowed to take part for Rally Leg 2.

### 12.3 Overnight halt - Parc Fermé

There is an overnight Parc Fermé area in use, situated at RealPark Lempäälä. More details in Rally guide. This overnight Parc Fermé is not in use for retired crews which are going to start again for Leg 2.

### 12.4 Leg 2.

Starting order for Leg 2. is the same as for Leg 1, also for the retired and ongoing competitors. Timecard for leg 2 will be given at the Parc Fermé OUT-Service IN TC. Classes 14-23 will start after other classes. More in the Rally Guide.

### 12.5 Speeding during the Rally

From speeding at the road section or at the service park during the Rally, measured by the police or the Rally organizer can Clerk of the Course impose following penalties:

1. infringement: Notice in writing and 90 € fine  
If speed is over 30km/h over the limit, Clerk of the Course can penalize competitors by exclusion from the rally.
2. infringement: penalty ordered by Clerk of the Course: Fine max 500 € or exclusion from the rally.

Fines must be payed to Rally Office before the preliminary official results being announced. Otherwise exclusion by the Stewards.

### 12.6 Finish

Finish of the Rally not includes Parc Fermé – area.

Protests against the cars must be made by phone (number is in the Road book) before the time when car is finished. In writing this protest must be made at least at the TC 10C Finish.

## 13. COMPETITORS MATERIAL

Road book (1pcs.) is given for every crew, road book includes detailed description of the route to be followed, and two (2pcs.) route maps at the time of registration. At the liaison's, if competitors don't use exactly route of road book it's lead to exclusion of the Clerk of the Course decision.

Classes 14-23 material is given one hour before each crew's starting time.

## 13. REGROUPING HALTS

During the rally, there is 2 halts with service possibility (15min, 20min) on Friday and 3 halts with service possibility (15min, 30min and 50min) on Saturday. There is also one (1) regrouping. For classes 14-23 there is one 30min halt with service possibility.



#### 14. TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

Technical scrutineering will take place in RealPark, Lempäälä, Realparkinkatu 4.  
Optional scrutineering at Friday 29<sup>th</sup> of September at 11.00-14.00 (from 11am to 2pm).

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> of September schedule will be given on Rally Guide.  
Scrutineering closes 10 minutes after the time given for the last competition number.

##### 14.1 Sealing of turbos and pop-up-valves

All cars to be sealed must attend to optional scrutineering Friday 29<sup>th</sup> of September at 11.00-14.00 (11am to 2pm).  
Replacing a sealed part must the Chief Scrutineer be informed by phone.

##### 14.2 Number of tyres in classes 1-6

Maximum number of tyres is 12 pcs.

During SS1 it is permitted to use four (4) pcs of tyres not counted on the tyres used for the event of the total amount. There must be at least four (4) of the similar tyres as for the SS1 has been reported to use in the car in question. Barcodes for these tyres are marked separately on the same tyre list and these tyres can not be used with other special stages. If the total number of tyres, including tyres for SS1, does not exceed 12, these tyres are allowed throughout the competition.

The competitor should submit all the tyres FIA – bar codes tire code form to the Security check.

If competitor's tyres are not equipped with FIA - bar codes, the organizer gives the alternative instructions.

The lack of bar codes must inform Chief Scrutineer Mr. Antti Hirvonen (phone +358503201757) before technical scrutineering.

14.3 Each competitor will have the right to carry a maximum of two spare tyres.

#### 15. RESULTS

Provisional classifications per competition class will be published as per schedule given in the Rally Guide.
